On November 16, 1963, Duskin established a small plant for cleaning and processing mats and mops on a land of about 260 m² in Saita City, Osaka. At that time, we only had a washing machine, dewatering machine, manual boiler, and two dryers disposed of by the U.S. military. After that, Duskin worked to forge an all-new culture of cleaning with "chemically treated dust cloth" that does not use water. We also brought the authentic taste of homemade donuts from the U.S. to Japan. Since then, we have continued to bring new joy to people in Japan based on the concepts of "always clean" and "always tasty."

With a sense of pride as an industry pioneer, **Duskin established the Duskin Museum in 2015, on the land where the company started its business.** The museum consists of two facilities: the Cleaning Pavilion, where you can have fun learning the history and effective methods of cleaning, and the MISDO Museum, which displays Mister Donut's past food products and other items and where you can experience making donuts.

1 Mister Donut Spirit


In a replicated living space, you can use Duskin products to experience cleaning.
